This is what we are working on in class:

- ◇ Exploring the 10s frame

- ◇ Counting 10 objects one at a time
- ◇ Recognizing numerals 0-10
- ◇ Simple patterns e.g. leaf, acorn, leaf acorn...
- ◇ Concept of more and less
- ◇ Recognizing dice numbers without counting

You can help by practicing these concepts with your child!



Literacy

This is what we are working on in class:

- ◇ Names of letters
- ◇ Phonetic sounds
- ◇ Hearing beginning sounds
- ◇ Print concepts (tracking print, parts of a book, the difference between a letter, a word and a sentence.
- ◇ Writing our own name and recognizing friends names
- ◇ Memorizing high frequency words
