Brightspace/D2L



All classes have a corresponding virtual Brightspace environment. Your virtual classroom will be the place where teachers post information about classroom events, topics being covered, if materials from home need to be brought in for projects, homework, newsletters, etc. Most grades/marks for tests and assignments can also be viewed on Brightspace so you are able to monitor your child's progress. If you are unsure of how to access this platform, or have forgotten your login information, please reach out to your child's teacher. Brightspace is your first stop to go to if you want information about your child's classroom.

Want to volunteer on your child's school field trip?

Don't wait until it's too late! All volunteers must have:

- ✓ A Vulnerable Sector Police Check on file (valid for 3 years)
- ✓ Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (A.O.D.A.) Training Certificate (completed online)
- ✓ Signed Volunteer Confidentiality Agreement

All 3 must be in order to attend the trip. If you would like to start the process, please contact Mrs. Murphy in order to receive the electronic letter. This letter is required to obtain your vulnerable sector check online with Police Services. This process may take as long as 4—6 weeks so don't delay!

School Health Guidelines for Parents & Guardians

Please keep in mind the guidelines set out by the Brant County Health Unit in regards to sending your child to school. If a child/student is having any of the following symptoms, they should automatically be excluded from attending school:

- Fever 38.0°C or higher stay home (self-isolate) and do not attend school until fever free and symptoms have been improving for at least 24 hours.
- Respiratory symptoms that are new or unusual stay home for 24 hours minimum until symptoms are improving (this includes cough, runny nose, nasal congestion, sore throat, and shortness of breath).
- Gastro symptoms (e.g., nausea, vomiting, diarrhea) that are new or unusual stay home for 48 hours from last episode.

If you are still unsure about when your child can return to school, you can also take the Self-assessment | Ontario.ca. Recommendations will be provided on what to do next. For more information, you can visit the Guidelines on the Brant County Health Unit's website:

Students Absent on Hot Lunch Days

Just a reminder if your child(ren) are absent on a hot lunch day—it will **not** automatically be wrapped up or left in the refrigerator until the next day unless you **call ahead and request this**. We are not able to ensure that all students absent that day will have their lunch saved. Any hot lunch item that is left in the refrigerator on a Friday will be tossed due to health and safety regulations.

Cold Weather Information

Students are required to go outside for recess for 20 minutes in the morning and 20 minutes in the afternoon. As we approach spring, we may still have some very cold wintery days ahead of us. Please be aware of temperatures each day by checking our local forecast so your children have appropriate clothing to enjoy the outdoors. Students should come to school with boots, hats, mittens/gloves and proper outerwear based on the weather. We also encourage parents to send an extra pair of socks, pants, and mittens/gloves which can be kept in your child(ren)'s backpack in case they get wet during recess. PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL YOUR CHILD(REN)'S BELONGINGS. Throughout the winter, we continually monitor the temperature and playground conditions for student safety.

St. Patrick's prayer for the faithful captures the wonderful spirit that made him Ireland's patron saint and one of the Church's most beloved missionaries.




