## Math

This is what we are working on:

- ◇ Counting to 100 (many are showing readiness!)
- ◇ Ordinal numbers 1st, 2nd, 3rd...
- ◇ Measurement using materials around the class
- ◇ Printing numerals
- ◇ Simple addition of two dice

## Literacy

This is what we are working on:

- ◇ Memorizing "off by heart words" (a, the, go, is, it...)
- ◇ Writing sentences using familiar words, phonics and adding detail
- ◇ Reading short class messages
- ◇ Identifying the main idea in a story
- ◇ Letter blends ch, th, sh
- ◇ Vowels and the 2 sounds they make
- ◇ Consonants that make more than one sound c and g
